- ***The deadline to have your paperwork completed, put in the mail, and postmarked is Monday, June 28, 2010.***
- ***Make sure you put sufficient postage on the envelope!***

****Please note that there is an additional form this year, the DAO "Taking Off Our Hats" policy. DAO relies on donations from various sources, many of which are home care providers that serve the bleeding disorders community. Because of these important relationships, it is critical that DAO camps be a place free from marketing or promoting companies that do business with the community. We now require volunteer staff at all of our camps to sign this policy statement, and in the interest of fairness to our volunteers as well as our donors, we also require adult participants to do the same. Therefore, all Adult Adventure Camp participants must sign the policy addition to the registration, medical, and risk acknowledgment forms. Make sure you have read and understand it so that we can avoid any potentially awkward or uncomfortable situations at camp which might result in asking a volunteer or participant to leave prior to the end of camp. **We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter.******

The 2010 Adventure Camp season will be filled with great times and inspiring people. We can't wait to see you at camp. Until then, paddle hard and we'll see you in the summer!
